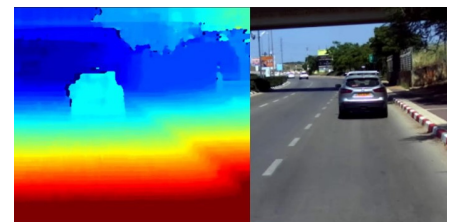

COMPLETION OF AUTOMATIC CALIBRATION SOFTWARE

RAIL VISION SIGNS FIRST COMMERCIAL AGREEMENT

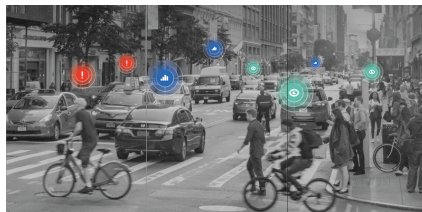

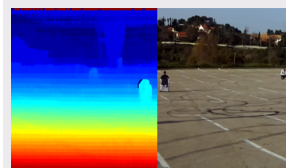
