HORIZON 2020 GRANT AWARDED

The European Commission, through the Horizon 2020 program, has awarded a funding grant of nearly 20 million Euro for the AWARD consortium to develop and operate safe autonomous heavy-duty vehicles in harsh weather conditions. Foresight will provide its QuadSight® multispectral vision solution, and is expected to receive a grant of approx. one million USD.
